Job Duties:

- Coordinates all activities related to procurement of a commodity beginning with intent to purchase through delivery.
- Analyzes the requirements of the commodity, including preliminary specifications, preferred supplier, and date commodity is needed.
- Solicits and evaluates proposals for the requested commodity.
- Negotiates the lowest possible cost for the commodity balanced against the optimum quality and schedule needs.
- Assures that the commodity is delivered on schedule, at the negotiated price, and meets the quality standards of the company.
- Evaluates written data, such as job orders, product specifications and operations sheets, parts
 and materials inventory lists, and machine and worker production rates, to establish efficient
 allocation and scheduling of parts, materials, machines, and sequences of operations and
 workflow.
- Compiles data from sources such as contracts, purchase orders, invoices, requisitions, and accounting report and enters the information into the computer system to maintain inventory, purchasing, shipping, and other records.
- Reviews the back-order file to make allocation adjustments or shipment adjustments as stock becomes available.
- Assists with tracking inventory, verifying material in active jobs and shipping, and receiving as necessary for Control products.
- Ensures quality control standards set by engineering are implemented in procurement documents and work orders.
